Weekday Torah Study Group

Tot Shabbat Service and Dinner

For families with young children, Rabbi Eisen holds a special Tot Shabbat Service the first Friday of the month. (Children need not be enrolled in our school to participate.) On **May 7 and June 4** at 5:45 pm (please note earlier time), we'll begin on the Bimah in the Sanctuary with stories and songs. The service is open to all. K'Ton Time

A fun and lively 20-minute service that includes songs, prayers, stories and games geared to families with kids ages 1 to 6, but every family is welcome. After the service everyone is invited to a kid-friendly Kiddush where each child's attendance is acknowledged in song. This is followed by playground time for kids, and schmoozing time for parents, after which we join the sanctuary service for kiddush. Minyan Shelanu: Our Minyan

This service is led by your fellow congregants and is for children and adults of ALL ages. We *daven* with *ruach* and the inspiration of a camp service! Throughout the year, we explore the meaning behind the prayers and music of the Shabbat morning service. The next service will be held on **Saturday, May 22 at 10:30 am** in the Epstein Chapel. Following the service, we join the sanctuary service for kiddush.

Summer Shul is back!



For several weeks we move our **9:00 a.m. Saturday service** into **Rabbi Breger Hall** instead of the sanctuary. The purpose is to enable us to set a different mood and a slightly different form to our service. We set up Rabbi Breger Hall as a Sanctuary: the chairs are placed in the pattern of a horse-shoe (concentric semi-circles) around a Reader's Stand and the *Aron Kodesh* is placed against the Eastern Wall. This will enable us to see and hear each other during the course of the service ... and to find our worship strengthened by our sense of togetherness. This year, we have planned our Summer *Shul* to take place **June 19 & 26, July 3, 10, 17, 24 & 31, August 7 & 14**. Please plan to join us ... beat the heat and stay cool in *shul*!

Daily Minyan Services & “Jewry” Duty

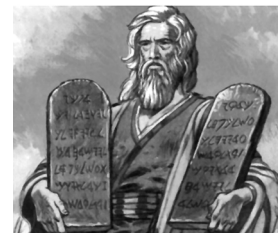

SHIV'A ASAR B'TAMMUZ

The 17th of *Tammuz* is observed as a fast commemorating the breaking down of the wall of Jerusalem by Nebuchadnezzar and the cessation of Temple worship during the siege of Titus. It ushers in the three weeks of mourning which end with *Tisha B'Av*, the fast of the ninth day of *Av*.

The three weeks between *Shiv'a Asar B'Tammuz* and *Tisha B'Av* are referred to as “between the straits,” a phrase borrowed from

SHAVUOT



The Shavuot Festival, otherwise known as Pentecost (50th day) or Feast of Weeks, was celebrated primarily as a thanksgiving for the wheat harvest; it falls seven weeks after the barley harvest, when an Omer of the new produce was offered. The Torah refers to Shavuot as Hag Ha-Katsir (The Feast of the Harvest) and Yom Ha-Bikkurim (The Day of First Fruits), observed by offerings of the best ripe produce of the fields (Exodus 23:16; Numbers 28:26).

In the course of time, and as a result of the transformation of the agricultural festivals into historical commemorations, the additional significance of Shavuot as the festival of the Giving of the Torah (*Z'man Matan Torateynu*) at Mount Sinai completely overshadowed its original significance. Though the Bible does not identify Shavuot with the anniversary of the giving of the Ten Commandments, the tradition, undisputed in the Talmud, has been that the Torah was given on the sixth day of Sivan.

Shavuot is called *Atzeret* in the Mishnah and the Talmud, in the sense that it serves as a concluding festival to *Pesah*. In the observances of *Shavuot*, the historical as well as the agricultural aspects are reflected. The Decalogue is read in the synagogue on the first day. The first night of the festival is often spent in reading an anthology of sacred writings called *Tikkun Leil Shavuot*. The Book of Ruth is read for its description of a summer harvest in Israel. Milk dishes are the customary foods, symbolizing the Torah which is likened to milk, according to the allegorical interpretation of the Song of Songs, “honey and milk are under your tongue.”

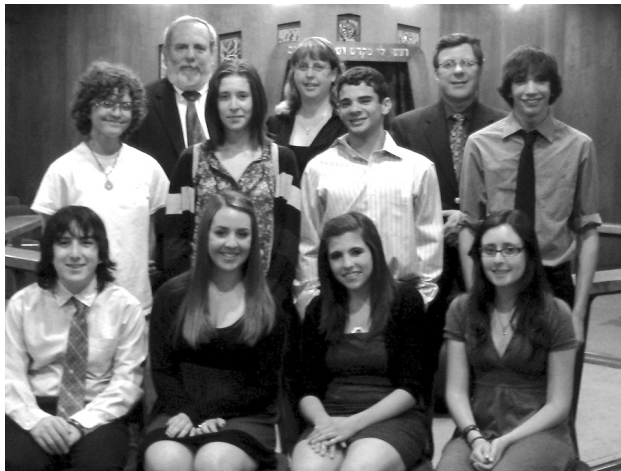
Lamentations 1:3. The *Mishnah* mentions five misfortunes that befell the Jewish people on the 17th of *Tammuz* and five on the ninth of *Av* (*Ta'Anit* 4:6).

The three weeks are concluded with the so-called Nine Days, from the first to the ninth of *Av*, during which the mourning is intensified until *Tisha B'Av* itself — the saddest day of the Jewish year.

This year the 17th of Tammuz falls on June 29th.

Israel's Bold Steps

Since being sworn in as prime minister in March 2009, Benjamin Netanyahu has broadcast his commitment to solving the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. He said he supports the creation of a demilitarized Palestinian state alongside Israel — an idea that Netanyahu, a lifetime Likudnik, had never publicly endorsed until his June 14 speech. The Palestinian Authority (PA) was unmoved by Netanyahu's change of heart.

Nonetheless, in November, Netanyahu went a step further, declaring a 10-month moratorium on all Israeli construction in the West Bank — a concession that Secretary of State Hillary Clinton called "unprecedented" in advance of negotiations. The PA was unmoved by that gesture, too, because the moratorium did not include neighborhoods in eastern Jerusalem such as Gilo, Har Homa, the Jewish Quarter of the Old City and student housing near Hebrew University.

While Israel carries out the moratorium, she is also taking steps to improve life for Palestinians in the West Bank. In the past several months, Israel has dismantled 185 roadblocks and checkpoints, enabling greater freedom of movement between Palestinian cities. Such openness was unheard of during the height of the Palestinian campaign of terrorist attacks that began in 2000. Israeli Arabs now routinely shop in the West Bank, boosting the economy there by about seven percent last year.

However, while Israel has taken these bold steps, the PA has done nothing to indicate its desire for peace with Israel. In fact, PA President Mahmoud Abbas told The Washington Post's Jackson Diehl last May that he expected the United States to pressure Israel while he sat and waited. "I will wait for Israel to freeze settlements," Abbas explained. "Until then, in the West Bank we have a good reality . . . the people are living a normal life."

In the same interview with Diehl, Abbas revealed how far-reaching then-Prime Minister Ehud Olmert's offer was in late 2008. Abbas said that Olmert showed him a map proposing a Palestinian state on 97% of the West Bank. Abbas also confirmed that Olmert "accepted the principle" of the "right of return" of Palestinian refugees — something no previous Israeli prime minister had done — and offered to resettle thousands in Israel. But Abbas did not accept Olmert's offer. Why? "The gaps were wide," Abbas said.

Abbas was not lying. The gaps between Israel and the PA remain wide because the PA maintains a maximalist position that is irreconcilable with Israel's most far-reaching proposals.

Yet, Israel continues to seek peace. As evidenced by Ehud Barak's offer to Yasser Arafat in 2000, Ariel Sharon's painful withdrawal from Gaza in 2005, Ehud Olmert's offer to Mahmoud Abbas in 2008 and Benjamin Netanyahu's bold steps in 2009, Israel is committed to peacefully ending the Israeli-Palestinian conflict once and for all.

The Band's Visit is both a clever, subtle slice-of-life comedy, and a poignant cross-cultural exploration.

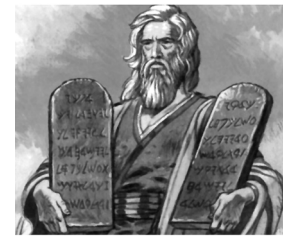

Do you or someone you know need a ride to *shul*?

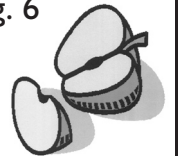

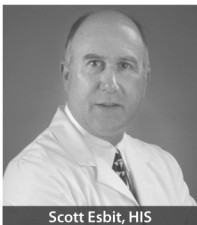

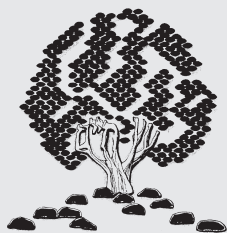
