

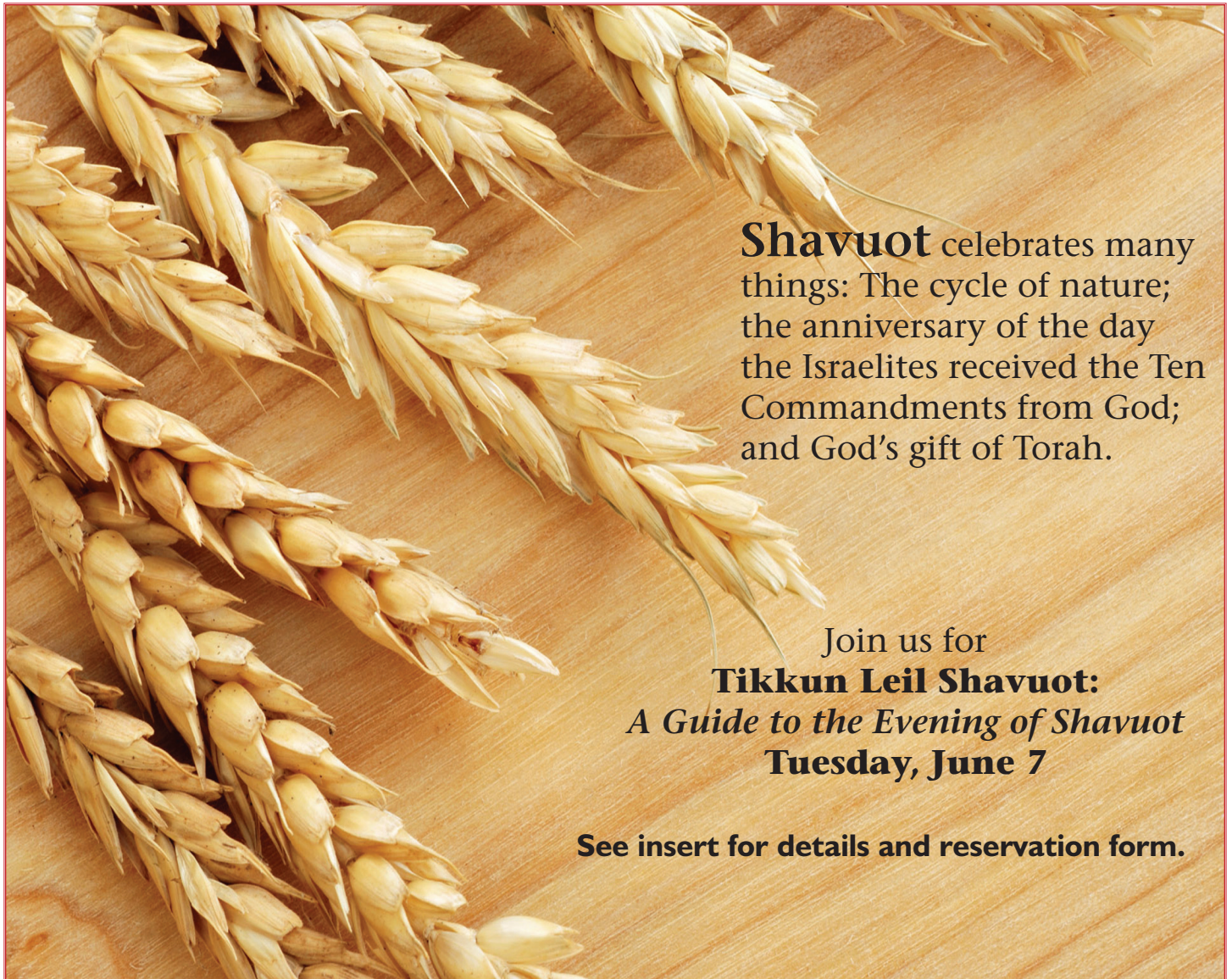

Weekday Torah Study Group

Summer Shul is back!



For several weeks we move our 9:00 a.m. Saturday service into Rabbi Breger Hall from the sanctuary. The purpose is to enable us to set a different mood and a slightly different form to our service. We set up Rabbi Breger Hall as a Sanctuary: the chairs are placed in the pattern of a horse-shoe (concentric semi-circles) around a Reader's Stand and the *Aron Kodesh* is placed against the Eastern Wall. This will enable us to see and hear each other during the course of the service ... and to find our worship strengthened by our sense of togetherness. This year, we have planned our Summer *Shul* to take place **June 11, 18 & 25, July 2, 9, 16, 23 & 30, August 6, 13 & 20**. Please plan to join us ... beat the heat and stay cool in *shul*!

Ma'alot Minyan

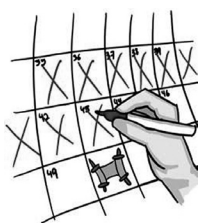
Minyan Shelanu: Our Minyan

This service is led by your fellow congregants and is for children and adults of ALL ages. We *daven* with *ruach* and the inspiration of a camp service! Throughout the year, we explore the meaning behind the prayers and music of the Shabbat morning service. Services will be held on **Saturday, May 28 at 10:30 am** in the Epstein Chapel. Following the service, we join the sanctuary service for *kiddush*.

The Counting of the OMER

You shall count for yourselves — from the day after the SHABBAT, from the day when you bring the OMER of the waving — seven Sabbaths, they shall be complete. Until the day after the seventh sabbath you shall count, fifty days ... —Leviticus 23:15-16

You shall count for yourselves seven weeks, from when the sickle is first put to the standing crop shall you begin counting seven weeks. Then you will observe the Festival of SHAVU'OT for the Lord, your God —Deuteronomy 16:9-10



According to the Torah (Lev. 23:15), we are obligated to count the days from Passover to SHAVU'OT. This period is known as the Counting of the OMER. An OMER is a unit of measure. On the second day of Passover, in the days of the Temple, an OMER of barley was cut down and brought to the Temple as an offering. This grain offering was referred to as the OMER.

Every night, from the second night of Passover to the night before SHAVU'OT, we recite a blessing and state the count of the OMER in both weeks and days. So on the 16th day, you would say "Today is sixteen days, which is two weeks and two days of the OMER."

The counting is intended to remind us of the link between Passover, which commemorates the Exodus, and SHAVU'OT, which commemorates the giving of the Torah. It reminds us that the redemption from slavery was not complete until we received the Torah.

This period is a time of partial mourning, during which weddings, parties, and dinners with dancing are not conducted, in memory of a plague during the lifetime of Rabbi Akiba. Haircuts during this time are also forbidden. The 33rd day of the OMER (the 18th of IYAR) is a minor holiday commemorating a break in the plague. The holiday is known as LAG B'OMER (the word "LAG" is not really a word; it is the number 33 in Hebrew). The mourning practices of the OMER period are lifted on that date.

This year, 2010, LAG B'OMER falls on May 2 (begins at sundown on May 1).

Our Cemetery - A Reminder

In response to several questions we have recently received: Several years ago we opened a new area of the Congregation Anshei Israel Section of Evergreen Cemetery to accommodate those of our members who are intermarried. This is an area that will accommodate the burial of persons of the Jewish faith either by birth or Halakhic conversion who are members of Congregation Anshei Israel and who freely declare their desire to be interred together with their non-Jewish spouse, and the burial of the non-Jewish minor children of such intermarried couples.

This area is adjacent to the northwest corner of section 27a (it continues west along the fence from where the flush marker section ends). The area was developed in such a way that the Halakhic standards of the current configuration of our cemetery have been preserved ... even as we acknowledge the integrity of this new area:

- The guidelines concerning burial in the currently configured and developed sections of the CAI Cemetery will not change (all must be according to Jewish Law).
- There are guidelines concerning burial in this portion of the CAI section of Evergreen Cemetery that will accommodate the burial of non-Jewish spouses and/or non-Jewish minor children of our members, along with those Jewish members of our congregation who so choose to be buried there ... and will protect the integrity of this special section.

SHAVUOT



The Shavuot Festival, otherwise known as Pentecost (50th day) or Feast of Weeks, was celebrated primarily as a thanksgiving for the wheat harvest; it falls seven weeks after the barley harvest, when an Omer of the new produce was offered. The Torah refers to Shavuot as Hag Ha-Katsir (The Feast of the Harvest) and Yom Ha-Bikkurim (The Day of First Fruits), observed by offerings of the best ripe produce of the fields (Exodus 23:16; Numbers 28:26).

In the course of time, and as a result of the transformation of the agricultural festivals into historical commemorations, the additional significance of Shavuot as the festival of the Giving of the Torah (Z'man Matan Torateynu) at Mount Sinai completely overshadowed its original significance. Though the Bible does not identify Shavuot with the anniversary of the giving of the Ten Commandments, the tradition, undisputed in the Talmud, has been that the Torah was given on the sixth day of Sivan.

Shavuot is called Atzeret in the Mishnah and the Talmud, in the sense that it serves as a concluding festival to *Pesah*. In the observances of *Shavuot*, the historical as well as the agricultural aspects are reflected. The Decalogue is read in the synagogue on the first day. The first night of the festival is often spent in reading an anthology of sacred writings called *Tikkun Leil Shavuot*. The Book of Ruth is read for its description of a summer harvest in Israel. Milk dishes are the customary foods, symbolizing the Torah which is likened to milk, according to the allegorical interpretation of the Song of Songs, "honey and milk are under your tongue."

February 20, 2011**

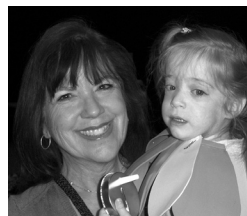

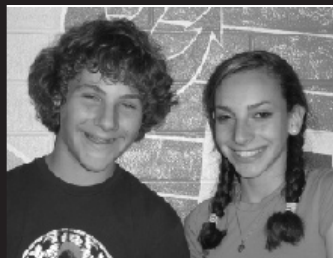

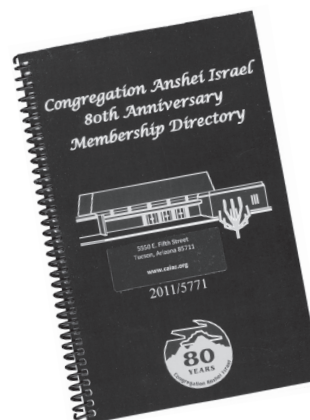
