### Lulav & Etrog



Blessing the lulav and etrog on Sukkot is the Jewish way of thanking God for the blessings of the earth. By holding the four species together — the branch of a palm (*lulav*), three myrtle branches (*hadass*), two willows (*aravot*), and a bright yellow etrog — we symbolically “get our act together.” When we point the lulav and etrog in six directions, we remind ourselves that God’s presence can be found in every area of our lives. By shaking the lulav and etrog vigorously, we commit to being “movers and shakers” in the world this year, for good and for blessing.

Add meaning to your Jewish life and create special memories for your family by shaking a lulav in your home!
