The service will include singing, clapping, participatory melodies, niggunim (wordless chants), and more involvement by all who attend. Everyone is welcome. It's a new way to embrace Shabbat!

### K'Ton Time

A fun and lively 20-minute service that includes songs, prayers, stories and games geared to families with kids ages 1 to 6, but every family is welcome. After the service everyone is invited to a kid-friendly *kiddush* where each child's attendance is acknowledged in song. This is followed by playground time for kids, and schmoozing time for parents, after which we join the sanctuary service for *kiddush*. ### Minyan Shelanu: Our Minyan

This service is led by your fellow congregants and is for children and adults of ALL ages. We *daven* with *ruach* and the inspiration of a camp service! Throughout the year, we explore the meaning behind the prayers and music of the Shabbat morning service. The next services will be held on **Saturdays, September 24 and October 22 at 10:30 am** in the Epstein Chapel. Following the service, we join the sanctuary service for *kiddush*.



### A Thank You ... Blessing ... To, Of and For Our Pets

Our pets are so much a part of our lives: a presence in our homes and in our hearts; companions in times of joy and comfort in times of pain. Our lives would not be the same without them. On **Sunday, October 30** – immediately after the Shabbat when we read the Torah Portion describing how God created the world (filled it with life!) and the week before we read the story of Noah (how, when the world was restored, that life was renewed as well – two by two!) – we will pause to recognize just how important our animals/pets are to us. At **11:45 am** we'll gather on the basketball court (near the sukkah) for a short "service" which will include a "blessing of our pets." We encourage everyone to come and gather with us (pets included) for this very special moment.

## TZOM GEDALIAH • Fast of Gedaliah

TZOM GEDALIAH (Fast of Gedaliah) is an annual fast day instituted by our tradition to mark the assassination of Gedaliah Ben Achikam, the Governor of Israel during the days of Nebuchadnezzar, the King of Babylonia.

In the time immediately after the destruction of the Temple and of Jerusalem itself by the armies of Nebuchadnezzar, most of the Jewish people who lived in the land of Judah were exiled. There were a few that remained. Nebuchadnezzar appointed a man named Gedaliah as governor.

Gedaliah advised the people not to accept the Babylonian rule and instead to work towards reestablishing normal life in the country. Unfortunately, there were people who disagreed with him. A man named Yishmael ben Netaniah, a descendant of the royal family, murdered Gedaliah and many other Jews. This murder was the final blow that completely destroyed the last remnant of organized Jewish community in the land of Israel until the Jews returned to build the Second Temple.

The story of Gedaliah is told to us in two places in the TaNaCh, in Kings II chapter 25 and in the book of Jeremiah chapters 40 and 41.

The "Fast" itself is considered a "Minor Fast" as it begins at daylight and not on the evening before. This year TZOM GEDALIAH falls on **Sunday, October 2**.

## Legacy Program: L'Dor V'Dor

Our new Executive Director, Michael Landy, questioned me recently regarding the difference between our Legacy Program and the Areivim Project. I understand the potential for confusion, so I'd like to clear up a few areas.

Congregation Anshei Israel has had a Legacy Program (endowment) for several years and it has had success. When the national Areivim Project chose Tucson as one of its three communities, CAI jumped at the chance to participate. This opportunity has been a real boost to our Legacy efforts. The Areivim Project provides incentive (up to \$18,000 over two years to each partner such as CAI), training and support to the volunteers, and challenges the Tucson Jewish community to step up its focus on endowing our future. When the Areivim project is completed at the end of 2012, our Legacy program will continue, but I believe that our volunteers will have more clear guidelines and knowledge and a feeling of success due to the Areivim experience.

Since January of this year, members of the Legacy committee have attended two training sessions. Reports and updates have been provided monthly to the Board of Trustees and to the Synagogue Life Council. A Legacy presentation was made by Esther Sherberg at CAI's Annual Meeting in May. At the May board meeting, Dana Adler, the Tucson Areivim Project Coordinator, presented a check for \$4500 and answered questions. Also during this period of time, committee members have met with or had conversations with 15 families. Our goal is to have each committee member meet with or have a conversation with one to two families each month. Future activities include a presentation at a Board Retreat on September 18 and a presentation during the High Holy Days. We also plan to update our Legacy brochure and come up with some vehicles for better marketing the Legacy Program.

Over the past few months we have been advised by the Jewish Community

Foundation of Southern Arizona that the following members have included CAI in their legacy planning: **Shiffy and Bob Cohen, Fern and Ed Feder, Madeline and Barry Friedman, Gail Mordka, and Andy and Stuart Shatken.** Our sincere thanks to each of you. I would also like to acknowledge a very generous bequest from Elsie Eisner, of blessed memory.

For over 80 years CAI has always made it a priority to be there for each and every member. By remembering the synagogue in your legacy planning, you will ensure that we will be able to do so for generations to come.

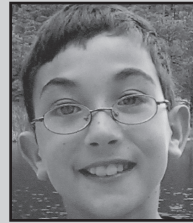

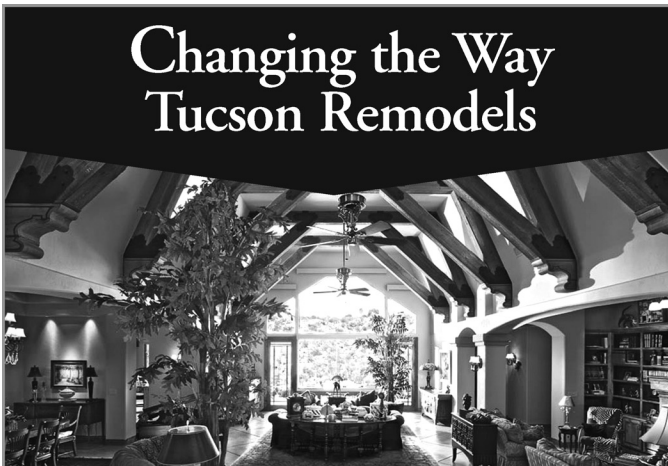
