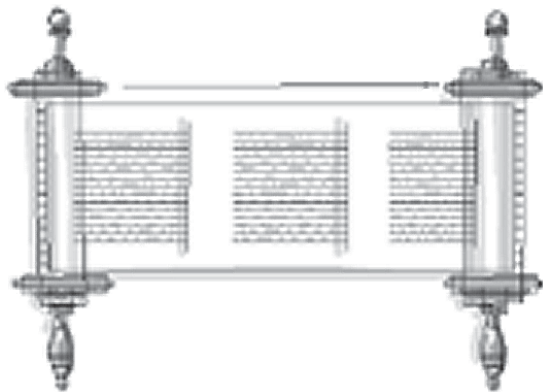


Learning About Ourselves



Independent of where any of us might fall in the spectrum of Jewish learning, there is one thing we all share in common: **There is always something new we can learn!** ... knowing that the more we learn about our history and heritage, the more we are really learning about ourselves.

Congregation Anshei Israel offers a two-year program to help us all meet that need to learn: Our **KABBALAT TORAH PROGRAM**.

Literally *Kabbalat Torah* would be translated as "The receiving of the Torah." The goal of the program will be to help us all better understand Torah so we can make it our own. Classes will be taught by your clergy and will be held on **Tuesdays from 7 – 9pm** for approximately 30 weeks each year beginning in August. The program will culminate in a service led by the students as a statement of their commitment to Torah and to living Judaism as a reflection of their *Kabbalat Torah*.

If interested in deepening your understanding of our history and heritage — diving into the rich reservoir of our culture and traditions — enhancing your level of observance (probing the meaning and function of the *mitzvot*) ... if you are serious about what it can mean to be a Jew, then this program is for you!

Our first session (registration, orientation and overview) for 5772/5773 (2012/13) will be held August 14. The fee is \$90 per year to cover materials, etc., but no one will be turned away due to financial need.
