Registration for the 5774/2013-2014 Religious School is now open! Here's the schedule for the coming year:

- Kindergarten and First grade will attend on Sundays 9:00am to 12:00pm.
- Second through Sixth Grades will attend on Sundays 9:00am to 12:00pm and Tuesdays 4:00 to 6:00pm.
- Seventh and Eighth Grade students participate in an exciting and engaging program combining an hour of formal education on Tuesdays 5:00 to 6:00pm, followed by dinner and an informal educational component as part of Junior USY.
- In addition to reconfirming a commitment to Religious School attendance, families are **expected** to attend Shabbat services (Shabbat Family Experience, Tot Shabbat, Junior Congregation, chapel or sanctuary services) at least twice a month.

You may order a copy of your child's Hebrew book for use at home (K-6th Grade only) on the enclosed Registration Form. Also, please complete the Permission Slip/Medical Form on the back. And remember to keep the 2013-14 Religious School calendar handy!

These forms are necessary for us to create a safe and secure learning environment; therefore, registration will not be considered complete until <u>both</u> forms are filled out <u>for each child</u> and returned in a timely manner. **PLEASE NOTE: See other side of this letter for changes to the registration fee structure (Kindergarten is now free!) and registration deadlines.**

New this year: We are offering on-line registration! You may have already received an e-blast with a link to the on-line Registration Form and the Permission Slip/Medical Form included here should you wish to register electronically.

The first day of school is Sunday, August 18. This next school year promises to be filled with laughter and learning. Our goal is to increase your child's love of Judaism. Thank you for allowing us to spend such valuable time with your children!
