** Shabbat is the first tractate (book) in the Order (Mishnaic section) of Moed, of the Mishnah and Talmud. The tractate consists of 24 chapters. The tractate primarily deals with laws relating to Shabbat, and the activities prohibited on Shabbat (the 39 prohibitions) and distinguishes between Biblical prohibitions and Rabbinic prohibitions. It also discusses special Rabbinic decrees to reinforce the concept of rest on Sabbath and to enhance its sanctity, such as forbidding pursuit of business, discussing forbidden matters and pursuing weekday activities.*



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
