Groups may observe life-cycle events, wish to learn more about Judaism, hold social events or any combination of these. Each Havurah plans its own social, educational and spiritual activities to meet the interests and needs of the group. There is never a membership fee to participate and groups usually meet once a month. Everyone is welcome: singles, married couples, all ages.
