### PLEASE NOTE: Friday, September 7

#### We will offer three(!) different SHABBAT Experiences:

At **5:45pm** we will hold our traditional **Mincha, Kabbalat Shabbat and Ma'ariv Service** in the Epstein Chapel. Held in the intimate setting of the Chapel, this service offers a "natural transition" from the "week that was" into the sanctity of the Shabbat. Also at **5:45pm**, we will hold our **Tot Shabbat Service** in the Sanctuary. And, we will hold our **"Shir Hadash: A New Song" at 7:30pm** in the Epstein Chapel (in addition to it being held on third Fridays at 5:45pm; see below). This special Shabbat evening service features Emily Ellentuck as Cantorial Soloist and includes singing, clapping, participatory melodies, *niggunim* (wordless chants), and more involvement by all who attend.

Led by Emily Ellentuck as Cantorial Soloist, we embrace Shabbat with a **"Shir Hadash: A New Song,"** our spirited, upbeat and inclusive service with participatory singing, clapping, kid-friendly melodies and *niggunim* (wordless chants). ### Mishpachah (Family) Minyan

## Blessing of Our Pets

Our pets are so much a part of our lives: a presence in our homes and in our hearts; companions in times of joy and comfort in times of pain. Our lives would not be the same without them!

Please join us on **Sunday, October 21 at 11:45am** – immediately after the Shabbat when we read the Torah Portion describing how God created the world (filled it with life!) and the week before we read the story of Noah (how, when the world was restored, that life was renewed as well – two by two!) – we will pause to recognize just how important our pets are to us. ## TZOM GEDALIAH • Fast of Gedaliah

TZOM GEDALIAH (Fast of Gedaliah) is an annual fast day instituted by our tradition to mark the assassination of Gedaliah Ben Achikam, the Governor of Israel during the days of Nebuchadnezzar, the King of Babylonia.

In the time immediately after the destruction of the Temple and of Jerusalem itself by the armies of Nebuchadnezzar, most of the Jewish people who lived in the land of Judah were exiled. There were a few that remained. Nebuchadnezzar appointed a man named Gedaliah as governor.

Gedaliah advised the people not to accept the Babylonian rule and instead to work towards reestablishing normal life in the country. Unfortunately,

there were people who disagreed with him. A man named Yishmael ben Netaniah, a descendant of the royal family, murdered Gedaliah and many other Jews. This murder was the final blow that completely destroyed the last remnant of organized Jewish community in the land of Israel until the Jews returned to build the Second Temple.

The story of Gedaliah is told to us in two places in the TaNaCh, in Kings II chapter 25 and in the book of Jeremiah chapters 40 and 41.

The “Fast” itself is considered a “Minor Fast” as it begins at daylight and not on the evening before. This year TZOM GEDALIAH falls on **Wednesday, September 19.**

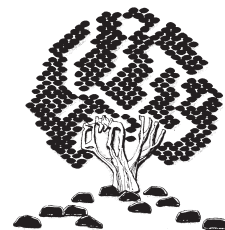

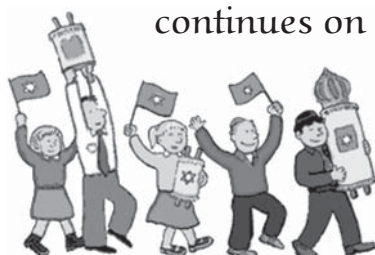
