SHIV'A ASAR B'TAMMUZ

The 17th of *Tammuz* is observed as a fast commemorating the breaking down of the wall of Jerusalem by Nebuchadnezzar and the cessation of Temple worship during the siege of Titus. It ushers in the three weeks of mourning which end with *Tisha B'Av*, the fast of the ninth day of *Av*.

The three weeks between *Shiv'a Asar B'Tammuz* and *Tisha B'Av* are referred to as "between the straits," a phrase borrowed from Lamentations 1:3. The *Mishnah* mentions five misfortunes that befell the Jewish people on the 17th of *Tammuz* and five on the ninth of *Av* (*Ta'Anit* 4:6).

The three weeks are concluded with the so-called Nine Days, from the first to the ninth of *Av*, during which the mourning is intensified until *Tisha B'Av* itself — the saddest day of the Jewish year.

This year the 17th of Tammuz falls on June 25.

SHAVUOT: THE FORGOTTEN HOLIDAY

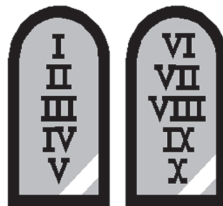
The Shavuot Festival, otherwise known as Pentecost (50th day) or Feast of Weeks, was celebrated primarily as a thanksgiving for the wheat harvest; it falls seven weeks after the barley harvest, when an Omer of the new produce was offered. The Torah refers to Shavuot as Hag Ha-Katsir (The Feast of the Harvest) and Yom Ha-Bikkurim (The Day of First Fruits), observed by offerings of the best ripe produce of the fields (Exodus 23:16; Numbers 28:26).

In the course of time, and as a result of the transformation of the agricultural festivals into historical commemorations, the additional significance of Shavuot as the festival of the Giving of the Torah (Z'man Matan Torateynu) at Mount Sinai completely overshadowed its original significance. Though the Bible does not identify Shavuot with the anniversary of the giving of the Ten Commandments, the tradition, undisputed in the Talmud,

has been that the Torah was given on the sixth day of Sivan.

Shavuot is called Atzeret in the Mishnah and the Talmud, in the sense that it serves as a concluding festival to *Pesah*. In the observances of *Shavuot*, the historical as well as the agricultural aspects are reflected. The Decalogue is read in the synagogue on the first day. The first night of the festival is often spent in reading an anthology of sacred writings called *Tikkun Leil Shavuot*. The Book of Ruth is read for its description of a summer harvest in Israel. Milk dishes are the customary foods, symbolizing the Torah which is likened to milk, according to the allegorical interpretation of the Song of Songs, "honey and milk are under your tongue."

## MITZVAH 613

Congregation Anshei Israel has commissioned the creation of a new Torah as part of a year-long celebration of its 83rd anniversary. A kick-off event, MITZVAH 613 TORAH FAIR, was held on Sunday, December 16, 2012, to allow all to participate in the fulfillment of the 613 Commandment by sharing with others in the creation of a new Torah. Our Israeli scribe, Zerach Greenfield, demonstrated the writing of a Torah and answered questions.

One of the spiritual duties of Judaism is that each Jew, in his or her lifetime, write a Torah in order to preserve the heritage of our ancestors. Since this is probably impractical for most individuals, the Talmud allows us to fulfill the mitzvah by sharing with others in the creation of a new Torah. Our MITZVAH 613 Torah Project is an opportunity to participate in a great mitzvah!

## Middle East Spotlight

### Israel the Innovator

The United States and Israel have developed a resilient friendship, based in large part on an unshakable dedication to common values. President Barack Obama's historic trip to Israel in March showcased the depth of the partnership and highlighted the expansive bonds that bind the two allies together.

While much of the attention on the relationship is focused on security cooperation, the president also spoke to the economic and technological benefits that the Jewish state provides the United States. In his Jerusalem speech, the president said that "Innovation is just as important to the relationship between the United States and Israel as our security cooperation."

According to *The Wall Street Journal*, The World Economic Forum ranks Israel among the world's top countries for technological and business innovation. More than 100 American companies have research and development facilities in Israel, including scores of major U.S. manufacturers — from General Electric to General Motors, Microsoft, IBM, Google and Apple.

Intel executive Greg Slater in January said that many of his company's major innovations over the past 30 years began in Israel — including two microprocessors which accounted for 40% of Intel revenues in 2011. Microsoft founder Bill Gates said in 2006 that the "innovation going on in Israel is critical to the future of the technology business."

The United States' first ever free trade agreement was signed with Israel in 1985. Since then, trade between the two countries has grown from \$4.7 billion when the agreement was signed to \$40 billion today. In fact, for seven years now, U.S. exports to Israel have equaled or surpassed those to oil-rich Saudi Arabia. While Israel represents just 3% of the population of the Middle East, it accounts for a full 25% of U.S. exports to the region.

One of the programs in place to support trade and business ties is BIRD, the Binational Industrial Research and Development Foundation. BIRD is a jointly-funded program that provides grants to high-tech research and development businesses. Since 1977, BIRD has funded more than 400 projects, generating sales of more than \$4.5 billion and creating an estimated 20,000 American jobs. And nearly 40 Israeli companies trading on NASDAQ have received funding from BIRD.

"Israel is already a center for innovation that helps power the global economy," said the President. Indeed the strategic relationship between the United States and Israel helps ensure that our economy continues to grow, our technologies continue to evolve and our interests are advanced every day.



## Social Action: Opportunities to Serve Those in Need

Tucson Interfaith HIV/AIDS Network (TIHAN), along with the Jewish Community Relations Council (JCRC) and other congregations, have an opportunity for adults who would enjoy creating and serving a meal to people living with HIV. The Poz Cafe is a once-a-month event that teams you with other volunteers to purchase and prepare a lunch for 125 people and visit with them, chat and create a positive experience. Our role would be to provide a chair person to represent CAI, form a committee to provide volunteers, and help with the cost of the meal. There will be staff available for guidance and additional volunteer support.

I want to update you on a new project we are working on with the JCRC called "Share our Simcha" (SOS) to organize a food rescue program (starting in the Jewish community). The goal is to collect and then distribute unused food to those in need. Look for our new web site (coming soon) with information about the program. As we progress in the development of the project, there will be volunteer opportunities.

As always, on behalf of the Social Action Committee, we thank all our volunteers who have helped to make our projects possible.
