
## THE TUCSON BOARD OF RABBIS PRESENTS

An October 1, 2013, Pew Research Center Report entitled, "A Portrait of Jewish Americans" details findings of a survey on the size, beliefs, practices and attitudes of the U.S. Jewish population. Included in the report are estimates of the American Jewish population using various definitions of who is a Jew; intermarriage and demographic characteristics; aspects of Jewish identity; religious beliefs and practices; attitudes toward and connection with Israel; and political views and social attitudes. The report concludes with the characteristics of people of Jewish background and Jewish affinity, including their answers to an open-ended question about the ways in which they consider themselves Jewish.
