Olli Heinonen is a senior fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School of Government's Belfer Center for Science and International Affairs. He is an expert in the areas of nuclear non-proliferation and disarmament, verification of treaty compliance, and transfer and control of peaceful uses of nuclear

energy. Previously, Heinonen served as the deputy director general and head of the Department of Safeguards at the International Atomic Energy Agency in Vienna. He has also led teams of international investigators to examine nuclear programs of concern around the world in places such as South Africa, Iraq, North Korea, Syria and Libya. His writings and interviews have been published in various national newspapers and magazines.
