# THE MITZVAH OF BIKUR HOLIM

Federal healthcare privacy regulations make it difficult for us to know when a member of CAI has been admitted to a hospital.

#### **BAT KOHEN/BAT LEVI**

In keeping with a position adopted within our movement which affirms that a woman whose father is a KOHEN or LEVITE may consider herself a BAT KOHEN or BAT LEVI for the purpose of receiving the KOHEN or LEVI ALIYAH when she comes to the Torah, we will, on those occasions when we call people to the Torah as KOHEN or LEVI, embrace those who are BAT KOHEN or BAT LEVI as being eligible to take such honors. We know that not all women will choose to do this, but for those who do, once they have claimed this status, from that point on they will be eligible only for the KOHEN or LEVI ALIYAH.

# The Tenth of Tevet Asarah B'Tevet

Date of the fast in 5776: December 22, 2015

Coming as it does a week after the last day of Hanukkah, the fast on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month of Tevet (Asarah B'Tevet) might easily be overlooked. It occupies, however, an important niche in the story of Israel and the history of our people.

The text in II Kings (25:1-4) tells us that on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the 10<sup>th</sup> month, in the ninth year of his reign, (588 BCE), Nebuchadnezzar, the Babylonian king, began the siege of Jerusalem. Three years later, on the 17<sup>th</sup> of Tammuz, he broke through the city walls. The siege ended with the destruction of the Temple three weeks later, on the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av, the end of the first Kingdom and the exile of the Jewish people to Babylon. It can thus be considered part of the cycle of fasts connected with these events: Tzom Gedaliah (3<sup>rd</sup> of Tishrei); Shivah Asar B'Tammuz (17<sup>th</sup> of Tammuz) and Tisha B'Av (9<sup>th</sup> of Av).

The first mention of this fast appears in Zechariah (8:19) where it is called the "fast of the tenth month..." (counting from the month of Nisan, which was the first month in Biblical times). Other references to the fast and the affliction can be found in Ezekiel 24:1-2 (the siege); Jeremiah 52:4-6.

However, although the fast is historically tied in with events surrounding the destruction of the First Temple, the purpose of the fast is not the commemoration of an historical event, but the state of affliction of the Jewish people.

- As with all Jewish fasts, the prayers for Asarah B'Tevet include Selihot, marking the day as an occasion for each of us to devote time to Teshuvah (repentance), the introspection that motivates us to reexamine our actions and change our ways. As the Talmud in Brachot says, "one who is afflicted should examine his or her actions and do Teshuvah."
- Asarah B'Tevet is the day of mourning for people whose last resting place or date of death is unknown (the Kaddish Clali).
- Asarah B'Tevet is one of four public fasts which begin at dawn (alot hashachar about an hour before sunrise), but do not carry additional restrictions, such as washing oneself or wearing leather shoes, etc. (while Yom Kippur and Tisha B'Av begin from dusk the night before). However, it is the only fast which is not brought forward or postponed if it falls on a Friday, a mark of its immense significance.



# Daily Minyan Services & "Jewry" Duty

Our Minyan is expected to be there when someone needs to say *Kaddish*. We hope you will consider being there for others, as there are occasions when

it is difficult to get a *Minyan*. Along with your "Jewry Duty," we ask that you consider committing to being part of the *Minyan* at least one morning or afternoon per month on a regular basis. Service times are on the calendar in each newsletter and on the synagogue's web site, *www.caiaz.org*. # A Message from the Board of Trustees and the Synagogue Life Council





As part of its vision for the coming term, the Board of Trustees has adopted the revitalization of CAI's committee and council structure and roles, with the goal of creating/improving opportunities for congregant involvement in creating programs, activities and ritual experiences. A major player in this effort is the Synagogue Life Council or "SLC." This article will provide a general overview of the Board and SLC responsibilities in supporting, managing and providing guidance to the various committees and councils.

The SLC was created in 2007 as part of governance restructuring of the Board. The SLC was charged with coordination and oversight functions for the ritual, social and educational needs of our congregation, while the Board retained direct responsibility for administrative and financial functions. The Board retained all responsibility for setting and managing policy.

As a starting point to this revitalization, the Board explored best practices for synagogues. Using a general template provided by the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism, we developed revised roles and responsibilities (Scopes of Work) for each committee and council. It is important to note that several of these committees have been functioning quite well over the years; in those cases it is a matter of "tweaking" direction and methodology. Other committees have been somewhat dormant for several years and will get a little "adrenaline boost" in re-establishing their functionality. We invite you to visit the synagogue's website (www.caiaz.org) to review the document. For those who would like a hard copy mailed to you, please contact the office.

Now the caveat: This structure has been created to provide a wide range of opportunities for congregant involvement; it will <u>only</u> be successful with your participation. Please don't hesitate contacting either of us for additional explanation or to explore ways of getting involved.

A brief update: The work of our Ritual Committee was very much evident during the High Holy Days services. Our Preschool/Kindergarten, Religious School and B'nai Mitzvah programs are well under way and our USY groups have been meeting. Again this year, our Social Action Committee is engaged in providing the food snack packs for Los Amigos School in conjunction with the Community Food Bank. The Adult Education Committee is working on the "Wisdom of Jewish Tucson" program. Rabbi Barkan and Board member Kim Spitzer have reorganized the Religious School Committee with a focus on reaching out to Religious School parents. The SLC-affiliated Women's League and Men's Club continue their planned activities.

SLC meetings are held most second Mondays each month at 7:00pm in the Cantor Falkow Lounge and are open to all congregants.






