

#### **Atid**

Atid means "future" in Hebrew. As Women's League for Conservative Judaism enters its second century, Torah Fund begins its 77th year, and the State of Israel enters its 71st, we look forward with joy to our future together with you, our sisterhood members and supporters of Torah Fund.

When the classical rabbinic texts speak of the future using the word atid, it usually appears in the phrase le'atid lavo, which means "in the future to come." By this they mean either the day when the Messiah will come, or olam haba, the afterlife. Contemporary Israelis are known to say, with optimism, yesh atid, which means "there is a future!"

How do you envision your future? Your personal future: the future of your family: the future of your community; of the United States, Canada, and Israel?
