Free Family Havdalah Program

During Saturday morning Shabbat Services, we will be reading *Parshat Noach*, the story of how Noah built an ark and saved all of the earth's animals from a flood.

Join us on Saturday evening, right before *havdalah*, as we learn about one of Arizona's most helpful and misunderstood creatures.

Bat expert Debbi Buecher will talk about bats, show a rescued bat, and we'll walk to a bridge that hosts thousands of roosting bats.

Shortly before sunset, hundreds of Mexican free-tail bats will venture into the sky to eat mosquitoes and other insects. Then we'll celebrate the transition from *Shabbat* to the rest of the week with the *havdalah* ceremony.
