Shavuot

The *Shavuot* Festival, Feast of Weeks, was celebrated primarily as a thanksgiving for the wheat harvest; it falls seven weeks after the barley harvest, when an *Omer* of the new produce was offered. The Torah refers to *Shavuot* as *Hag Ha-Katsir* (The Feast of the Harvest) and *Yom Ha-Bikkurim* (The Day of First Fruits), observed by offerings of the best ripe produce of the fields (Exodus 23:16; Numbers 28:26).

In the course of time, and as a result of the transformation of the agricultural festivals into historical commemorations, the additional significance of *Shavuot* as the festival of the Giving of the Torah (*Z'man Matan Torateynu*) at Mount Sinai completely overshadowed its original significance. Though the Bible does not identify *Shavuot* with the anniversary of the giving of the Ten Commandments, the tradition, undisputed in the Talmud, has been that the Torah was given on the sixth day of *Sivan*.

SIn the observances of *Shavuot*, the historical as well as the agricultural aspects are reflected. The Ten Commanments are read in the synagogue on the first day. The first night of the festival is often spent learning with the community, called *Tikkun Leil Shavuot*. The Book of Ruth is read for its description of a summer harvest in Israel. Milk dishes are the customary foods, symbolizing the Torah which is likened to milk, according to the allegorical interpretation of the Song of Songs, "honey and milk are under your tongue."

We are stronger together!

Last month, Jewish communities around the world celebrated God bringing us out from slavery in Egypt and leading us to the promised land of Israel.



At the first collaborative Tucson community Passover
Seder in April, over 135 community members from all over Tucson
joined together to celebrate the second night of Passover at a seder.
I led with Rabbi Stephanie Aaron of Temple Chaverim a fun and
interactive seder. The seder was filled with thoughtful discussions,
at least 4 questions, the sounds and laughter from many kids
celebrating passover and of course songs and the retelling or our
story. It was incredible to join in a community space with so many
loved ones and new friends.

During the seder we remembered how bitter life in slavery was and we concluded the Seder with prayers for a rebuilt and peaceful Jerusalem. We cannot end our efforts simply with prayers. We must work together to help Israel live up to her own highest ideals.

One way we do this is by celebrating Israel and her successes. I am so thrilled to have joined with the Wientraub Center and community volunteers around Tucson to celebrate 75 years of Israeli statehood with a community-wide immersive festival experience for all ages. The event was an incredible success for the entire Jewish community. We had music, food, art, lectures, games, activities, vendors, inflatables, wine & whiskey tasting, face-painting, and so much more! I also taught a fun felting craft workshop!












